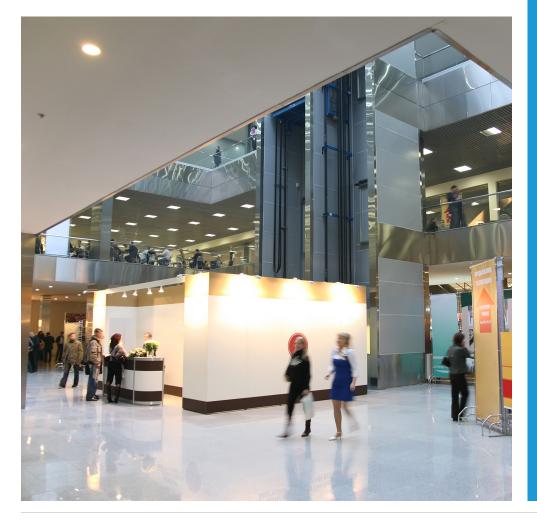

Rebates are for interior lighting that is used on a regular basis:

- » From 3 to 6 p.m.
- » Every day of the work week
- » From June 1 to Sept. 30
