Notice of Intent to Close CCR Unit
Gypsum Storage Area**

The Gulf Clean Energy Center (“GCEC”) owned and operated by Florida Power & Light Company (“FPL”) located in Escambia County, Florida at 11999 Pate Street, Pensacola, Florida includes one Coal Combustion Residuals (“CCR”) surface impoundment, the Gypsum Storage Area (“GSA”), that is subject to the Hazardous and Solid Waste Management System: Disposal of Coal Combustion Residuals from Electric Utilities; Final Rule [40 Code of Federal Regulations (“CFR”) Part 257, Subpart D (“Federal CCR Rule”)] and Florida Department of Environmental Protection (“FDEP”) Rules 62-701.804 and 62-701.805, Florida Administrative Code (“F.A.C.”), (“Florida CCR Rule”).

On behalf of FPL and pursuant to the Federal CCR Rule and Florida CCR Rule, Geosyntec is providing this notification of FPL’s intent to close the GSA. In closure of the GSA, FPL intends to use the closure by removal method in accordance with the requirements of 40 CFR § 257.102(c) and Rule 62-701.804(3), F.A.C.

Currently, CCR from the GSA is being removed for beneficial use. Therefore, closure of the GSA will commence within 30 days of removing the known final volume of CCR for the purpose of beneficial use in accordance with 40 CFR § 257.102(e)(1)(ii).

This notice of intent to close the GSA will be placed in the facility’s operating record and posted to the publicly accessible CCR Rule Compliance Data and Information internet site within 30 days of the date of this memo.
